

Are you passionate about young people's wellbeing? Would you enjoy deliving role playing sessions with enthusiasitc teenages? Then apply for our 'Youth Games Master' position.

Aims:

We are delivering a council-funded holiday club for young people aged 11-16 using Dungeons and Dragons, with an aim to:

- Provide space for young people to build relationships and community
- Provide a social activity that reduces the risk of isolation
- Create a fun atmosphere in which young people enjoy their time
- Keep young people safe and promote their wellbeing
- Provide a healthy meal for young people who may be on 'free school meals'
- Provide an entry point into a new hobby for some young people

Purpose of the role:

We are looking for a games master who can prepare and safely run a D&D adventure across 16 days in summer, and support the provision of ahealthy meal. Young people may not consistently attend each day, therefore flexibility is key.

Job Description:

- Preparing and running D&D adventures for 16 days during the summer holidays
- Maintaining excellent safeguarding practises
- Support the preparation of food
- Maintain accurate records of attendance

Person Spec:

To be eligible for this role you must be able to:

- Demonstrate an awareness of safeguarding procedures
- Show experience of running Dungeons and Dragons games as 'games master'
- Have worked with children and/or young people in some capacity
- Demonstrate you have worked well in a team with others
- Pass safer recruitment checks, including a DBS check and references

You may also be able to show:

- You have experience of running D&D with young people aged 11-16
- You have experience of making/supplying healthy food for young people
- You have formal safeguarding training
- You have a teaching, youth work, or similar qualification

Details:

- Rate of pay is minimum wage +15%
- 4 week contract for a total of 16 days (a total of 85 hours)
- It's not expected annual leave will be granted during the contract, due to the short-term nature of the work
- There's a possibility of extending to a weekly position for 3 hours per week, from September.
